

Guide to Schluter® Trim


The majority of tile projects will require some form of trim. You can opt for bullnosed or glazed edged tile or perhaps trim pieces, but maybe you've chosen a specialty shape or perhaps tile trim just isn't your style. If either of these things is the case, Schluter® might be for you. Schluter® is a trim option usually made from metal, like aluminum, stainless steel, and brass but also available in PVC. Schluter® comes in many different profiles to provide a smooth and finished edge that hides the rough and cut edges of your tile installation. *Please note, Fireclay Tile does not currently sell Schluter® trim. Your installer should be able to assist with sourcing Schluter® trim samples or purchasing.*






